#### A little bit about you

Supporting sector leaders to drive the change needed to tackle inequalities in physical activity and sport is key to Leading the Movement. We're looking to add to our existing Co-Design Group. The group comprises a diverse range of people with different skills, leadership experience and backgrounds. We're looking to add to the group with leaders who:

- have experience of working:
  - · for a local authority
  - · in an allied sector, for example health and wellbeing
  - in senior leadership roles (from Director level upwards) within the sport and physical activity sector
  - as a Senior Independent Director or Chair of a Board
- are aspiring sector leaders, including younger individuals (under 23)



- are from groups that are under-represented in leadership and board roles in our sector, specifically;
  - disabled people, women, non-binary people, people from culturally, ethnically and religiously diverse backgrounds, people with a state school education, people who haven't been to university, people from a lower socio-economic background, and members of the LGBTQ+ community.
- are responsible for Equality Diversity and Inclusion, and/or workforce development
- are experienced in systems-change, including those new to the sector or working in a complementary sector; and
- have experience of engaging in co-design processes to support content creation, training and networking opportunities.

We do not expect any individual to have all these attributes. These are suggestions of the type of mix we are looking for across the combined group.
